Missions Prayer Emphasis | Mark & Susie Edworthy Krakow, Poland

Fifty people attended the first service, and soon the church started youth clubs, English classes, outreach on campuses, and evangelism projects. It was unusually successful in just a year. Here's what happened: It was the second time Mark and Susie served in Poland. In 1991, they went to Poland the first time, but after some years, moved to another place to serve. They returned to Poland for a second assignment in 2016. They knew the language, knew many people, and knew what to do. Soon, people were accepting Christ through the church. Today, let us celebrate this wonderful ministry by our missionaries, Mark and Susie! It is so good to know our church is supporting them every month as we give. Let's pray for them and ask God to continue to bless their work there in Poland.
