Elementary School Partnerships

We are blessed to serve meals on special days to the teachers at Burlington and Mountain View elementary schools. We also help with special projects for the schools and children/families in need as opportunities arise. Please pray for our members who teach in these schools, for all the teachers, and for the many children and families who need to know of the great love and hope we find in Christ alone.

Night to Shine | PURE

Through the PURE ministry, we provide support and encouragement for individuals with special needs and their families through a monthly night out for parents, an Upward basketball team, and other activities throughout the year. In partnership with other churches, we participate in hosting the Tebow Foundation's Night to Shine, a special prom event for individuals with special needs age 14+. Pray that God would bless us with many families to know, love, and serve through these efforts to show the love of Christ.

WinShape Roanoke: Summer Camp

We serve as Roanoke's host location for Chick-Fil-A's Winshape Camps for Communities. The week-long, day camp serves students who have completed grades K-8 with an experience that combines sports, recreation, arts, and worship. A professionally-trained staff shares the gospel through a meaningful, unforgettable, and fun-filled experience. Pray for the children, their families and for enough scholarship funding and volunteers to serve every child who wants to participate.

Upward Basketball and Cheer: Dec-March

Practices begin in December with games on Saturdays from early January through early March. Pray for the families who do not know Christ and those searching for a church home. Pray for the safety of the players and for the coaches and volunteers to glorify Christ in all they say and do.

Brian and Kenny Polhamous

In Nov 2016, we commissioned Brian to plant a church in the remote village of Las Marias, Honduras. While there, he met a sister missionary, Kenny, and they eventually became engaged and were married. Later this year (2019), Brian and Kenny will come to the U.S. to study at a seminary and then be deployed as full-time missionaries.

The Reedy Family - Nagoya, Japan

The Reedy family serves Christ on mission in Nagoya, Japan. Jason works with Christ Bible Institute (CBI) to host pastors and evangelists to strengthen the church and offer hope to people trapped in a culture of despair. Pray for language acquisition for the family and for Anna as she teaches in a Christian school. Pray for many Japanese to surrender their lives to Jesus.

Iglesia Bíblica Metro - Carolina, Puerto Rico

We are praying for Andrés Laracuenta who is planting a church in his hometown of Carolina, Puerto Rico. Carolina is home to 200,000 Puerto Ricans and is a part of the greater San Juan capital region. Pray for the health of the church, people to be saved, and our mission teams as they go.

North American Mission Board (NAMB)

We partner with over 46,000 churches to train and send church-planting teams to strategic cities (SEND Cities) in the U.S. and Canada that have few Christians or evangelical churches. Pray for God to encourage these church planters in their work and for Him to save many.

International Mission Board (IMB)

We partner with over 46,000 churches to send missionaries to people who have little or no access to the gospel. By sending missionaries through the IMB, they do not have to raise ongoing support. Pray that God would call at least five individuals and/or couples from our church to serve with the IMB as missionaries by 2030.
